Dear Sir/Madam,

On November 14, 2024, Dense Air Networks US, LLC ("DAN US, LLC" or "the Company") filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CC&N) to provide intrastate telecommunications services. DAN US, LLC filed the application in support of the launch of its Radio Access Network as-a-Service ("RaaS") to service providers, municipal entities, and other enterprise customers throughout the state of Arizona. RaaS uses Open RAN network architecture in combination with Citizens Broadband Radio Service spectrum or licensed spectrum to deliver secure high-speed (4G/5G) connectivity solutions to business customers over a neutral host network infrastructure. The furnishing of RaaS requires certain physical arrangements of equipment and facilities of the Company and other entities, including fiber optic cables, small antennas, and conversion equipment attached to poles and other structures.

Based on information not available at the time of the filing, it is now DAN's understanding that a CC&N is not required in order for the Company to provide the services described in its application. Accordingly, I respectfully request the withdrawal of the pending application, without prejudice, and that this docket be closed.

DAN US, LLC will refile its application in the future in the event that its business plans or service offerings change in a way that brings them within the scope of services for which a CC&N is required.
